GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

Program name: Mongolia Water Compact

The Government of Mongolia has received a grant funding of 350 million US dollars under the Compact Agreement signed on July 27, 2018 with the USA Millennium Challenge Corporation with an aim to enable the Government to implement the Compact Program and achieve its objectives set forth in Compact. Millennium Challenge Account-Mongolia, an accountable entity established to oversee the implementation of the Compact, intends to apply parts of the proceeds of the funds to payments for contracts for certain goods, works, and services.

This General Procurement Notice covers the period from April through December, 2019 with the total estimated contract value of 3 million US dollars.
